TUESDAY

- Read Matthew 24:42-51

What is the reward for faithfulness?

How will you live today in a way that actively prepares for the coming of the Lord?

WEDNESDAY

- Read Matthew 25:14-30

What did the master expect his servants to do with what he had entrusted to them?

What was the reward the master gave to the faithful servants?

What has God given you with which you are to be faithful?

THURSDAY

- Read 2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

How does Paul express confidence in the Thessalonians faithfulness?

What does the faithfulness and steadfastness of Christ have to do with your faithfulness?

As you think through your day, ask God for the strength to be faithful to Him today especially in times

FRIDAY

- Read 2 Timothy 4:1-8

In what ways is Paul calling to Timothy to be faithful?

How has Paul indicated his faithfulness to God?

How is God calling you to be faithful in serving and obeying Him?

SATURDAY

- Read Revelation 3:7-13

In what ways has the church in Philadelphia been faithful to Jesus?

What is the reward to those who persevere and are faithful?

Ask God to show you where He wants you to increase your faithfulness to Him.
