- Read Romans 10:1-15

In what sense is Christ the end of the law for those who believe?

In what sense is there no distinction between Jew and Greek?

FRIDAY

- Read Romans 10:16-11:10

What is God's salvation plan for Israel in relation to the gentile world?

How do you know that God has not rejected Israel?

SATURDAY

- Read Romans 11:11-36

How do these verses further explain the salvation plan for Israel and for the world?
