MONDAY

- Read Psalm 63

Marking all the times that David says “you” in reference to God, how does David relate to God?

How does this instruct you as you seek to grow in relationship with God?

How will you practice these things today?

TUESDAY

- Read Psalm 42

How do the difficult times experienced by the writer of this Psalm affect his faith in God?

How has your faith in God been affected by your life circumstances?

Ask God today to renew your faith and desire for Him.

WEDNESDAY

- Read Psalm 84

Why does the writer of this Psalm find such joy in the presence of God?

How would you compare your desire for the presence of God with the desire of the person writing this Psalm?

Ask God to increase your desire for Him.

THURSDAY

- Read Psalm 119:1-16

What are you to seek? (Verses 2, 10)

How do you demonstrate that what you are to seek is God?

How will you demonstrate today that you are seeking after God?

FRIDAY

- Read Isaiah 55:6-11

According to these verses, what does it mean to “seek the Lord while he may be found?”

What is the connection between the word of the Lord and seeking the Lord?

How will you seek the Lord today?

SATURDAY

- Read Jeremiah 29:10-14

Under what conditions will the Lord be found?

Why do you think these are the conditions?

How are you doing in seeking the Lord in this way?
