What is the implied purpose of meeting together?

Why are we not to neglect meeting together?

What opportunities do you take to meet regularly with the body of Christ where this kind of mutual encouragement can take place?

THURSDAY

- Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-11

Who is given spiritual gifts?

Why were we given spiritual gifts?

How are you using the gift God has given you for the encouragement and benefit of others?

FRIDAY

- Read Romans 14:13-19

What is the way these verses suggest that believers are to build up one another?

Can you think of an example of how your behavior might cause someone else to stumble?

How will you seek to build up another believer today?

SATURDAY

- Read Hebrews 4:11-13

What part does the Word of God play in keeping your heart from going astray?

How have you seen God's Word work in this way in your life?

What has God been saying to you this week about your heart?
