MONDAY

- Read Matthew 28:16-20

Why did Jesus remind the disciples of His authority?

Why did Jesus remind the disciples of His continued presence?

How will you live today with a greater sense of His authority and presence in your life?

TUESDAY

- Read Acts 1:6-8

What did Jesus tell the disciples not to be concerned about?

What did Jesus tell the disciples to be doing while they waited for Him?

How will you be a witness for Jesus today?

WEDNESDAY

- Read Acts 10

What is God teaching Peter through the vision that He gives to Peter?

Why was this a significant lesson for Peter (a Jew) to learn?

What did the Holy Spirit do while Peter was preaching the gospel?

THURSDAY

- Read Matthew 10:1-15

Having been given authority by Jesus, what were the disciples to do?

What was the content of the message the disciples were to preach?

Ask God to give you opportunity today to tell someone about Jesus.

FRIDAY

- Read Matthew 10:16-23

What should all disciples expect to experience as they seek to tell others about Jesus?

How will disciples experience the presence of Jesus during these times?

Ask God to give you opportunity today to tell someone about Jesus even if it means suffering.

SATURDAY

- Read Matthew 10:24-42

How does Jesus define who is His disciple?

What are some of the costs of being a disciple of Jesus?

What are the promises Jesus gives to His disciples?

As you look at how Jesus defines a disciple, evaluate your own discipleship to Jesus. Ask Jesus to show you how to be a more consistent whole-hearted follower of Jesus.
