- Read Galatians 5:13-18

FRIDAY

- Read Colossians 2:16-23

What constitutes self-made religion?

Why are you not to submit to man-made regulations?

Are there areas of your life where you are living by man-made regulations instead of God's Word?

SATURDAY

- Read 1 Corinthians 8

How would the eating of meat cause some believers in Corinth to have stumbled into sin?

What was Paul willing to do to ensure he was not the cause of someone's sin?

Can you identify areas of your life where your behavior might be causing someone to sin?
