FRIDAY

- Read Psalm 73

What is causing the writer of this Psalm to doubt the goodness of God?

What is the turning point for how the writer feels? (Verses 16-17)

How can you keep God before you today?

SATURDAY

- Read Psalm 91

What are the promises that God gives to those who take refuge in Him?

How do you need God to be your refuge and fortress?
