MONDAY

- Read Romans 10:13-15

Why is proclaiming the truth about Jesus necessary?

What are some excuses people use for not sharing the gospel?

What excuses do you typically use?

TUESDAY

- Read 2 Timothy 4:1-5

What is to be your state of readiness in sharing the truth with others?

Even though Timothy was a pastor, not an evangelist, why does Paul want him to do the work of an evangelist?

How can you do the work of an evangelist today even if you don't consider yourself to be an evangelist?

WEDNESDAY

- Read 1 Corinthians 1:17-2: 5

Why did Paul specifically say that when he told others about Christ it was not with eloquent speech?

How did Paul describe his own presentation of the gospel in 2:1-5?

How does this knowledge help take the pressure off of you when you present the gospel to someone?

Ask God to give you an opportunity to share the gospel with someone today.

THURSDAY

- Read Romans 1:8-17

In what sense is Paul under obligation to share the gospel?

What is Paul's attitude toward sharing the gospel with others?

What is your level of eagerness in sharing the gospel? How could your level of eagerness increase?

FRIDAY

- Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

What are the essential elements of the gospel that Paul communicated?

Why is the resurrection the central key piece of the gospel?

Ask God to give you an opportunity to share the gospel with someone today.

SATURDAY

- Read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

How does Paul seek to make his preaching of the gospel more effective?

Why does an obedient and attractive life make the gospel more believable?

How will you seek to do more to win more?
